What Sugar Does in a Dog's Stomach

Sugar is a molecule that is osmotically active—meaning that if a high sugar solution is added to one side of a semi permeable membrane with just water on the other side, the water is going to shift in an attempt to equalize the two compartments.

When a dog ingests a large amount of sugar, an accumulation of water can follow. If this overwhelms the dog's ability to drink enough water—or particularly if he is vomiting—it can lead to abnormal electrolytes, particularly sodium.

Did you know....

The entire lily plant is toxic: the stem, leaves, flowers, pollen, and even the water in a vase. Eating just a small amount of a leaf or flower petal, licking a few pollen grains off its fur while grooming, or drinking the water from the vase can cause your cat to develop fatal kidney failure in less than 3 days.
